

Our Mission and Vision

Our mission is to empower faculty and staff with the knowledge, tactics, and philosophies necessary to protect and defend innocent lives and minimize mass causalities in the event of an intruder, active killer, or other terror attack.

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We expect every school to have enhanced security and planning for the worst-case scenario. We expect schools to train and prepare for an intruder or active killer, as one would do for fires, natural disasters and other critical incidents. The Active Threat Response Program for Schools was authored, developed and first implemented in 2013 by Guardian Defense founder, Steven S. Smith. As a current certified law enforcement officer since 2007, Mr. Smith has held many positions within the department, including patrolman, homeland security detective and various undercover positions. Mr. Smith also became a member of the SWAT Team in 2009. Most recently, Mr. Smith became an instructor on the SWAT Team in 2014 and Team Leader in 2015. He has worked directly in schools to change policies and train staff to respond to active threats.
